



Logo of the DIFA, developed in 2010, is a positive and powerful symbol of the international deaf football community. It connects together following elements: Sign language, deaf culture, unity and continuity.

Logo of the DIFA represents a circle with red edging. On the top of the edging there is an inscription DEAF INTERNATIONAL FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION, below there is an inscription – an abbreviated name of the Organization in English – DIFA.

At the centre of circle on background of outlines of continents of the Earth the human figure with a football ball is represented that displays an orientation of the Organization on development of football all over the world. 4 Regional Deaf Sports Confederations: APDSC, CADS, EDSO and PANAMDES participate in development of football in the world.

The wavy line of hands of a human figure means not only rhythm of palpitation, as a symbol of passion and emotions. Also it and dynamics of Sign Language, in which hand of the deaf man constantly are in constant movement.

On the ball the element of the International Signs designating word "sports" is displayed. All continents are displayed in green colour appropriate colour of a grass, colour of a football ground.

Thus, on the logo all key concepts describing DIFA are displayed: Football, Deaf people, International unity.
